End of Validity of Self-Arming Permission Letter *** Royal Government

- Having seen the Constitution of the Kingdom of Cambodia;
- Having seen the Royal Decree No. NS/RD/ 1198/72 dated November 30, 1998 on Appointment of the Royal Government of Kingdom of Cambodia;
- Having seen the Royal Kram No. 02/NS/94 dated July 20, 1994 on promulgation of Law on Organizing and Functioning of Council of Minister;
- Having seen the Sub-Decree No. 62/SD/E dated July 31, 1995 on Administration of Arms and Explosives;
- To ensuresocial stability, safety and order

DECIDES

- Article 1: Self-Arming Permission Letters issued by any of Authorities, Ministries, Institutions, or Officials other than terms stated in article 8, 9 and 10 of Sub-Decree No. 62/SD/E dated July 31, 1995, are put in to an end of validity.
- Article 2: Anyone who fails to comply with article 1 of this Decision shall be subject to punishment as stated in article 2 and article 5 of Law on Punishment of Illegal Arming and Uniform Dressing promulgated by Decree No. 11 KR dated February 07, 1992.
- Article 3: Other provisions which are inconsistent with this Decision shallbe abrogated.
- Article 4: Minister in charge of the Council of Minister' office, Co-Ministers of Interior, Co-Ministers of National Defense, Commander in chief of Royal Cambodian Arm Force, National Police Commissioner, relevant Ministers and Secretary of State, and Municipal and Provincial levels must effectively implement this Decision starting from the date of signature.
