SUB DECREE ON Scholarship and Dormitory Living Allowance for Students Studying in Public Schools

- Having seen the Royal Decree No. NS/RKT/0913/903 dated 24th September 2013 on the Appointment of the Royal Government of Cambodia;
- Having seen the Royal Decree No. NS/RKT/1213/1393 dated 21st December 2013 on the Adjustment of the composition of the Royal Government of Cambodia;
- Having seen the Royal Kram No. 02/NS/94 dated 20th July 1994 promulgating the Law on the Organization and Functioning of the Council of Ministers;
- Having seen the Royal Kram No. NS/RKM/0196/01 dated 24th January 1996 promulgating the Law on the Establishment of the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sport;
- Having seen the Royal Kram No. NS/RKM/1207/032 dated 08th December 2007 promulgating the Law on Education;
- Having seen the Sub Decree No. 102 ANKr.BK dated 03rd October 2002 on Setting Separated Expenditure for Implementing the Prioritized Activities Program in the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sport;
- Having seen the Sub Decree No. 10 ANKr.BK dated 12th April 2004 on the Daily Subsistence Allowance Inside and Outside the Country;
- Having seen the Sub Decree No. 84 ANKr.BK dated 09 June 2009 on Organization and Functioning of the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sport;
- Request from the Minister of Education, Youth, and Sport.

HEREBY DECIDES:

Chapter 1

General Provision

Article 1:

The purpose of this Sub-decree is to determine scholarship and monthly dormitory allowance for students to support their living during the period of study.

Article 2:

The objectives of this Sub-decree are:

- Provide scholarship to students/learner in the level of Specialized Primary Education, Specialized Secondary Education, Undergraduate, and Graduate.
- Provide allowance for all types of government civil servants who the competent Ministry/ Institution authorize to join workshop, in-service training, and other skill-upgraded trainings inside the country by

Article 3:

This Sub-decree covers all students/learners who are studying in public schools and all types of government civil servants who the competent Ministry/ Institution authorize to join workshop, in-service training, and other skill-upgraded trainings inside the country according to the Law on Education.

Article 4:

Key words used in this Sub-decree shall be attached as Annex.

Chapter 2

Levels and Conditions of Scholarship and Allowance Providing

Article 5:

Monthly scholarship for students who study in Public Higher Educational Institutes and Specialized Institutes shall be determined as following:

- Graduate:	80,000 Riel
- Undergraduate:	45,000 Riel
- Specialized Secondary level:	40,000 Riel
- Specialized Primary level:	30,000 Riel

Article 6:

Number of students who receive scholarship shall be determined as following:

Graduate level: 25per cent
 Undergraduate level: 10 percent
 Specialized Secondary level: 30 per cent
 Specialized Primary level: 35 per cent

For students who study in the fields that prioritized by the government or necessary fields for the society such as Sport and Teachers for all levels shall receive 100 per cent scholarships.

Article 7:

Monthly scholarship allowance shall be provided during study period. Regarding holiday during long vocation and study suspension, students shall not receive any scholarship allowance.

In case students repeat class, the government will end the scholarship, except student teacher.

Article 8:

Scholarship providing shall be implemented according to prioritized principle as following:

- 1- Well disciplined and high achieving students;
- 2- Orphans who live in poverty;
- 3- Children of ethnic minorities living in the remote areas;
- 4- Students from poor families.

Among the above four priorities, female students shall have the first priority.

Article 9:

The determination of students' names to receive scholarship and evaluating inspection to provide priorities as mentioned in the article 6 and 8 of this Sub-decree shall be carried out once a year by Scholarship Selection Committee of the Public Higher Educational Institutes.

Procedure and Organization and Functioning of the Scholarship Selection Committee shall be stipulated in the Prakas of the Ministers of each relevant Ministries/Institutions.

Article 10:

All Public Higher Educational Institutes that transformed into Public Administration Institutions shall use their own budgets to provide monthly scholarship allowance to scholarship students who are studying at their institutes as mentioned in Article 5, 6, 7, and 8 of this Sub-decree.

Article 11:

For all types of government civil servants who the competent Ministry/ Institution authorize to join workshop, in-service training, and other skill-upgraded trainings inside the country for the duration of 1-10 days shall receive accommodation fee and subsistence allowance according to the law of the government. Participants who live 10km far way shall receive subsistence allowance of 10,000 riel per day.

For the courses with study period from 11 days to 12 months shall receive dormitory allowance of 8,000 riels per day and not allow receiving subsistence allowance set by the government. Participants who live nearby can stay in their own home in the city/ province and receive the subsistence allowance of 5,000 riel per day, and provide on the day of fulfilling the duty.

Article 12:

Students from ethnic minorities and poor families come to stay in the dormitory of secondary school, high school or village center that have a dormitory shall receive daily subsistence allowance of 4,200 riel per day and allowance for sleeping materials and study materials on a yearly basis of 100,000 riel.

Chapter 3

Final Provision

Article 13:

Scholarship and dormitory living allowance for students studying in Public Schools shall be implemented from $01^{\rm st}$ January 2014 onwards.

Relevant ministries/ institutions shall prepare regulations to implement this Sub-decree.

Article 14:

Sub-decree No. 18 ANKr.BK dated 15 May 1997 on Scholarship and Dormitory Allowances and all provisions that are contrary to this Sub-decree shall be abrogated.

Article 15:

The Co-Ministers of the office of the Council of Ministers, Minister of the Ministry Economy and Finance, Minister of the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sport, and Directors of all relevant institutions shall be responsible to implement this Sub-decree effectively according to their respective duties from the date of signature and onwards.

Annex

of Sub-decree No. 174.ANKr.BK dated 05 May 2014 on Scholarship and Dormitory Living Allowance for Students Studying in Public Schools

Graduate Level: refers to educational level that students/learners shall complete conditions of Bachelor degree or its equivalent as a basic for continuing education and the duration of study is from one year onwards.

Primary Specialized Level: refers to educational level that students/learners shall complete conditions of general primary education or its equivalent as a basic for continuing education and the duration of study is from 6months to 3 years based on specialized fields.

Secondary Specialized Level: refers to educational level that students/learners shall complete conditions of general secondary education or its equivalent as a basic for continuing education and the duration of study is from 2 year to 4.5 years based on specialized fields.

Living Allowance: refers to daily subsistence allowance, sleeping materials, and study materials for supporting students who live in the dormitory.

Skill Training: refers to training that provides set of knowledge, skills, and value to upgrade capacity to have adequate capacity to fulfill the roles and responsibilities.

In-Service Training: refers to continuing training to develop profession according to schedule or necessity of the Ministry/Institution.

Upgrade Training: refers to continuing training to improve capacity to perform better in their existing roles and responsibilities.

Workshop: refers to meeting to disseminate, consult, guide, exchange experience... to participants according to target.

Scholarship: refers to financial provided to learners for supporting their studies during the period of learning.
